Extra ways to raise

The Giving Machine



The Giving Machine is a really easy way to raise money whilst doing your online shopping. Sign up to the website, choose Ataxia UK as your charity, and every time you buy online from places such as Amazon, The Trainline, iTunes and Ebay, we'll receive a donation based on your purchases made via www.thegivingmachine.co.uk.

Everyclick

Everyclick is a search engine that donates money to your favourite charity. Once you've registered, set www.everyclick.com as your home page and use it every time you search – every click raises money for Ataxia UK.



Gift Aid



Fancy adding 28% on top of your donation at no extra cost to you? Currently, we receive 25% plus 3% transitional relief from the government on top of eligible donations – this is called Gift Aid and it might not be around for ever.

In order for us to claim Gift Aid on donations, you must pay tax in the UK equal or more than the amount of tax we can receive on the donation. We can claim Gift Aid on donations and from sponsorship forms, as long as we have the donor's home address and post code – business donations or payment for services (eg a ticket to an event) are not eligible. So, if you pay tax and want to donate to Ataxia UK, always tick the Gift Aid box or ask us for a form. Your £20 donation is currently worth £25.60 at no extra cost to you!

Direct Debits

Donating annually, quarterly or monthly is an easy way to support Ataxia UK and it enables us to plan more accurately for the future. Regular gifts are one of our most important and valuable sources of income. Simply fill in a Direct Debit form and we'll do the rest! You can cancel at any time or pause your giving if needed.
